# Classroom Organisation

Home reading books and reading diaries must be brought to school everyday. Home reading books can be changed daily.

Extra curricular activities - Please ensure your child knows when and where they are attending activities after school.

Mandarin text books do **not** need to be taken home daily.

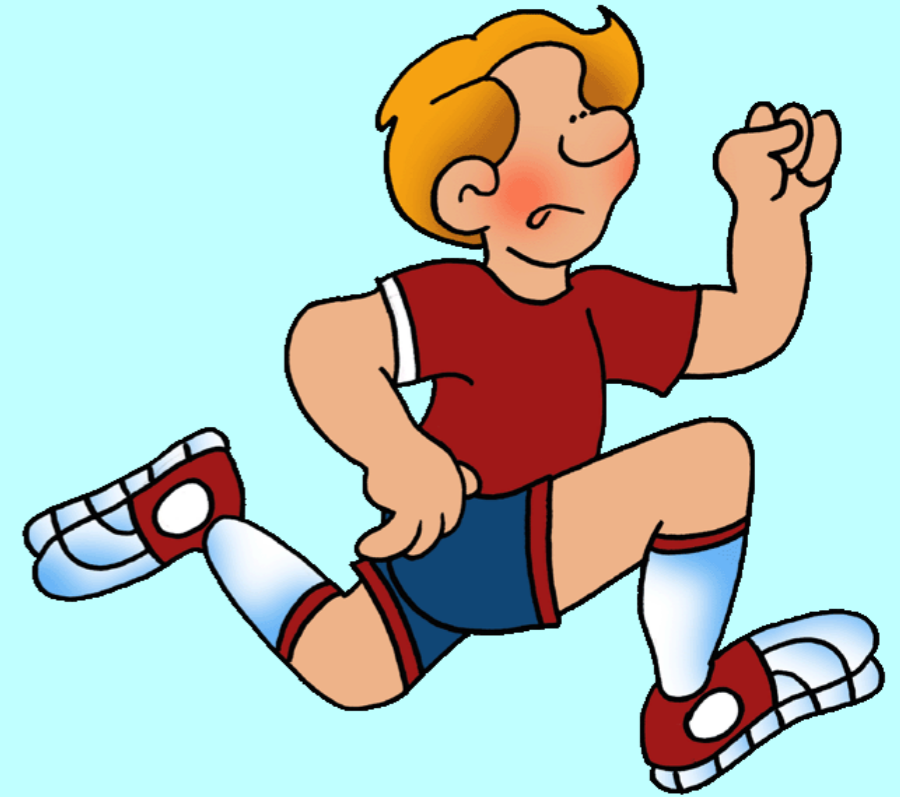
# PE

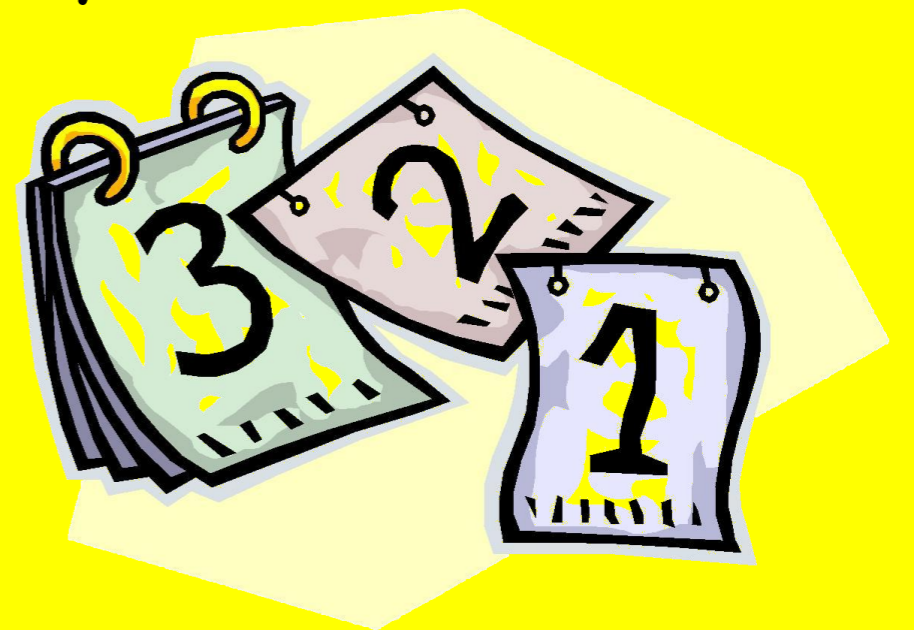
